Dear **Members and Friends**,

What a difference a few days make! With **Scott Brown's** Massachusetts Senate race victory this past Tuesday, passage of **ObamaCare now seems in doubt!** Senator-elect Brown has promised to be the 41st vote to kill the bill.

Many **Association members and friends**, acting as individuals, contributed time and money to the Brown effort.

Others, like **Kevin Street of the Delaware Tea Party**, and **Association member, Don Adams**, traveled to Boston as volunteers for the **Americans for Limited Government's non-partisan Voter Integrity Project**.

The purpose of the Project was to monitor polling places for possible election fraud and/or campaign violations—from either campaign.

Street and Adams reported that they encountered only minor infractions. The election process produced few complaints.

It's now clear that our efforts to educate the public at Tea Parties, Town Halls, and Congressional Rallies may have delayed passage of the disastrous, trillion dollar health care bill just long enough to possibly bury it.

However, **House Democrats** haven't given up. They're planning to ram a new bill (similar to the current one) through the House using the **reconciliation process**. A bill introduced in this fashion would require only simple majorities in both the House and Senate for passage.

Representative Curt Schroder (R-Chester) will introduce **House Bill 2179** in the PA House to begin the process of Amending the State Constitution to **allow Pennsylvania to opt out** of the onerous and costly comprehensive federal health care bill should it pass in any form. **A rally in support of the bill** will be held at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, January 27 in the Capitol Rotunda.

In other good news, both the January 10 **Candidates Forum**, sponsored by the (Bucks County) **Kitchen Table Patriots**, and the January 12 **Welcome Back Legislators Tea Party**, sponsored by the **Delaware Tea Party** (held in Dover) were very successful!
